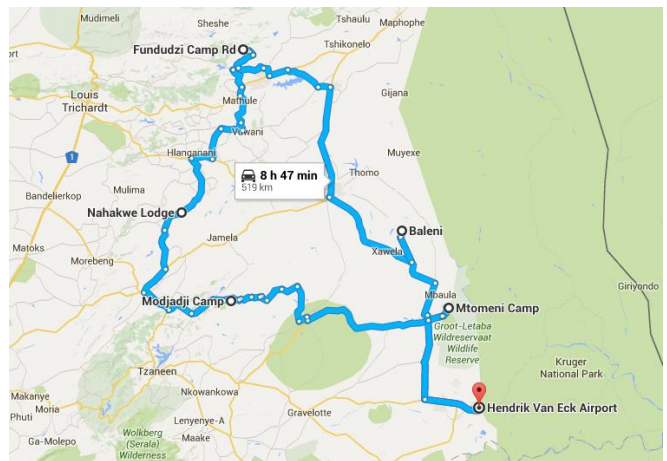

Walk on the wildside in South Africa's Limpopo province. An 8 night / 9 day itinerary.

Limpopo province offers a range of beautiful destinations that encourage outdoor activities. The friendly people and beautiful scenery contributes to an unforgettable experience. With a mixture of places, and animal experiences, this itinerary with a variety of single day, guided walks provides extraordinary variety. All accommodation en-suite.



Start: Phalaborwa (airport or local guesthouse pick-up)

Day 1: Transfer to *Mtomeni Camp* in Letaba Ranch. Late afternoon game drive or walk

Day 2: Morning and afternoon walk in the game reserve, Letaba Ranch.

Day 3: Transfer to *Modjadji Camp* in the Cycad Reserve. Long afternoon walk through the Cycad Reserve.

Day 4: Transfer to *Nahakwe Lodge* after early morning self-guided walk. En-route, visit the home of the Rain Queen, and the Sunland baobab.

Day 5: Follow the Elim Art Route, driving to the studios of various artists and crafters and ending the day at *Fundudzi Camp*.

Day 6: Visit Phiphidi Falls, walk through the Sacred Forest & hike to the view-points of Lake Fundudzi – this is a combination walking and driving day.

Day 7: Guided walk to Tshatshingo Potholes for a swim and relaxation.

Day 8: Drive from Fundudzi through the city of Thohoyandou, & the taxi rank market in Giyani. Arrive at *Baleni Camp* and walk to the hot spring and salt harvesters. End the day learning traditional Tsonga dance in camp.

Day 9: Return to Phalaborwa

Tariff options:

1. Guided and catered in group
2. Self-drive with guide assistance only in camp
3. Catered, part catering or self-catering available for self-drive guests.
